# Spring-Clean Your Medicine Cabinet with April 29 Drug Take-Back Day

BlueCross-sponsored Count It! Lock It! Drop It! TM program hosts drug collection events in Davidson County

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** — Nashville-area residents can join the fight against prescription drug abuse and misuse by dropping off unused or expired medications at one of seven National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day events on Saturday, April 29.

The event aims to provide safe, convenient locations to dispose of prescription drugs and other medications and to raise awareness about the potential risks for abuse and misuse of certain medications, such as opioids.

As part of the Drug Enforcement Administration's National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day, six area Walgreens and two St. Thomas Health locations will accept unused medications from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Residents looking to dispose of leftover or unwanted drugs can drop them off at any of the following sites:

Drug Take-Back Day efforts are supported by the BlueCross BlueShield of Tennessee Health Foundation's partnership with the Count It! Lock It! Drop It!<sup>TM</sup>(CLD) program, which aims to curb or eliminate opioid misuse and abuse in the Volunteer State.

According to CLD co-developer Kristina Clark, Tennessee is second in the country for opioid prescribing, and ranks fourth in the nation for the number of opioid deaths.

"These Take-Back events are a great way to raise awareness about the opioid crisis in our state," Clark explains. "More than half of Tennesseans who use opioids recreationally indicate they get them from a friend or relative, so it's important to safely secure your prescriptions and dispose of them once they are no longer needed."
